



Landscaping:
Stangtung Maple Trees will line both sides of Kingshighway.



Utilities and Aesthetics:
Power lines will be removed along the corridor. New lighting and a 8-foot bike and hike trail on the north side of the corridor will be constructed and a 5-foot sidewalk on the south side.

Benefits of project:

Kingshighway has heavy volumes of traffic and safety problems. This project helps traffic flow and improve safety, not only for drivers but also pedestrians. This project will improve traffic on Kingshighway from Highway 72 to US 63 (Bishop Ave.) as well as improve sidewalk and multi-use paths.
